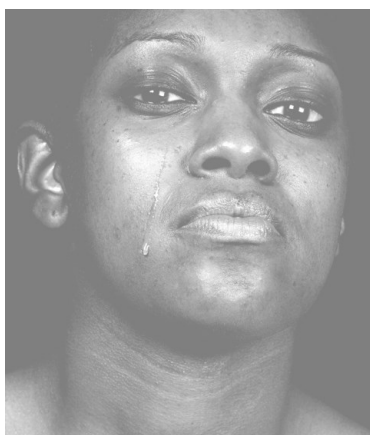

## 2018 Day for Life—Human trafficking and modern slavery

Jesus tells us, "I have come that you may have life, and have it to the full." (John 10:10 NJB).



But many people do not have life to the full. They have fallen victim to the scourge of human trafficking and modern slavery. People are not commodities to be traded ruthlessly for criminal profit.

Indeed, this is something that is happening in communities across our country, not just in our big cities. Trafficking is a growing problem and the UN estimates that over 40 million people worldwide are in slavery. In the UK alone, it is estimated that every year there are over 13,000 victims of trafficking from all countries.

Criminals exploit some of the most vulnerable and desperate people. We can act together to stop this.

### How Can We Help?

There are many organisations working to put a stop to human trafficking and modern slavery. One of these, the Santa Marta Group, works internationally to bring the Catholic Church and law enforcement agencies together to eradicate slavery. 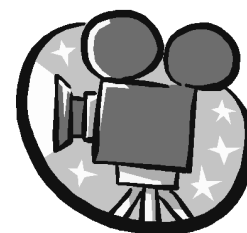
