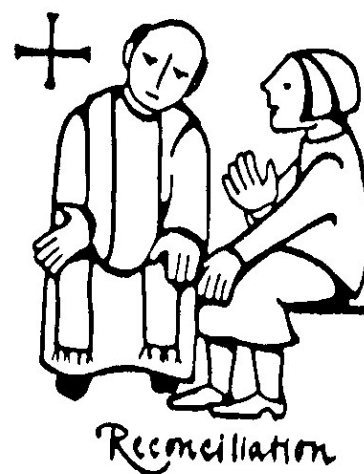

The requiem mass for Tony Bianchi will be held on:

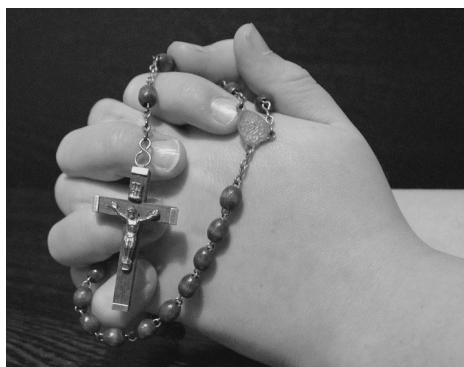
Wednesday 19 July at 12.30pm

Why does the address change to 'Churchbuilder'?

We are using a secure on-line system called 'Churchbuilder' which, as well as a website, is a church management tool to help manage the day-to-day administration of our parish.

If you receive an email from the website you will notice the word 'Churchbuilder' in the email. If you filled in the Parish Directory (pink) form your contact details are now in this secure system.

Only the clergy and the Parish Secretary can see your contact details.

What's new about the website?

The new website has a 'public' and a 'private' side. The public website can be seen by everyone who visits the site. The private side of the website is for parishioners only and is accessed by logging into the private part of the system.

Who can log in? And how do I log in for the first time?

Anyone who is in our Parish Directory can log into the private side of the website. Go to the website, click on **Members**, then select, **Login**. A login screen will appear click **Help I can't get in** and follow the instructions.

Once identified as a parishioner you will be sent an activation code and you can choose a username and a password.
