It's a fantastic musical which you can check out on the Hairspray 2017 tour website, or at the Buxton Opera House website.

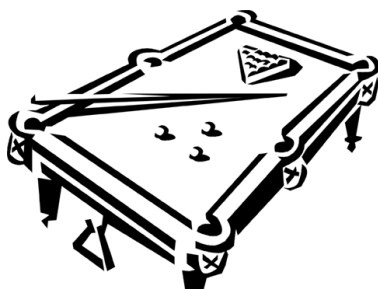
If you miss it in Buxton, it's at the Manchester Opera House next April!
