It is a very human trait to try to avoid pain and suffering – for ourselves and those we love; we have a natural instinct to protect ourselves and others.

In today's Gospel when Jesus predicts his forthcoming suffering, Peter's natural instinct kicks in, 'Heven preserve you, Lord; this must not happen to you.'

And yet Jesus knows that suffering is part of life and part of his mission, just as it is part of our life and part of the cost of discipleship. To follow Jesus we have to share in the cross, accept and carry our own crosses, and sometimes the crosses of others, of those we love.

Reassuringly in today's Gospel Jesus promises that any sacrifices we accept, any suffering we endure in our following of Jesus and the Gospel, in our discipleship, will be rewarded; what we sacrifice and lose, we will find!
