Reflection:

In this week's Gospel, Jesus begins to prepare the apostles for his Ascension which we will celebrate on Thursday 18th; Jesus will return to the Father, his mission on earth accomplished and the apostles and disciples will be left to carry on the mission of Jesus.

There are 2 elements in the Gospel for reflection:

Jesus is the way to the Father and declares himself as, 'The way, the Truth and the Life'. What do we understand by that statement? Do we really believe it?

The second is the emphasis that Jesus and the Father are one; united, inseparable, in communion. It takes us to the heart of the doctrine of the Trinity; three persons – one God, united in love. What do we understand by that statement? Do we really believe it?

Save Your Stamps

There is a plastic wallet on the notice board at the back of church for used stamps which we are collecting to support The One Project in Macclesfield.

This community group aims to promote sustainable living and runs three stalls on the indoor market to reduce the amount of waste sent to landfill:

- A stall collecting items for recycling that are not included in the council 'grey' bin recycling scheme, such as medicine blister packs, crisp/biscuit/sweet packaging, coffee bags, old toothbrushes and much more
- A 'swap shop' for clothing and household items
- A 'garden shed' stocked with a range of DIY items to borrow or use for a small donation.

The group also manages a number of urban gardening schemes in the town and organises regular litter picks, including after the monthly Treacle Market.
